



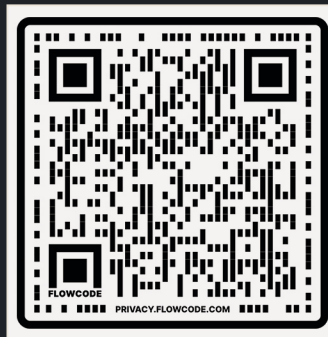
Weeksville Heritage Center is an historic site and cultural center in Central Brooklyn
